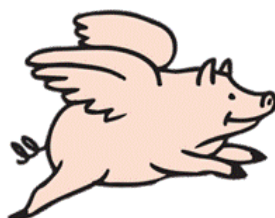

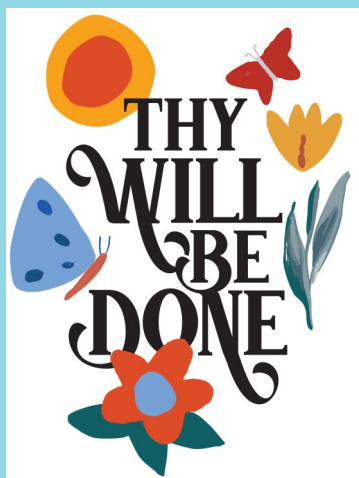
A prayer for Holy Boldness
